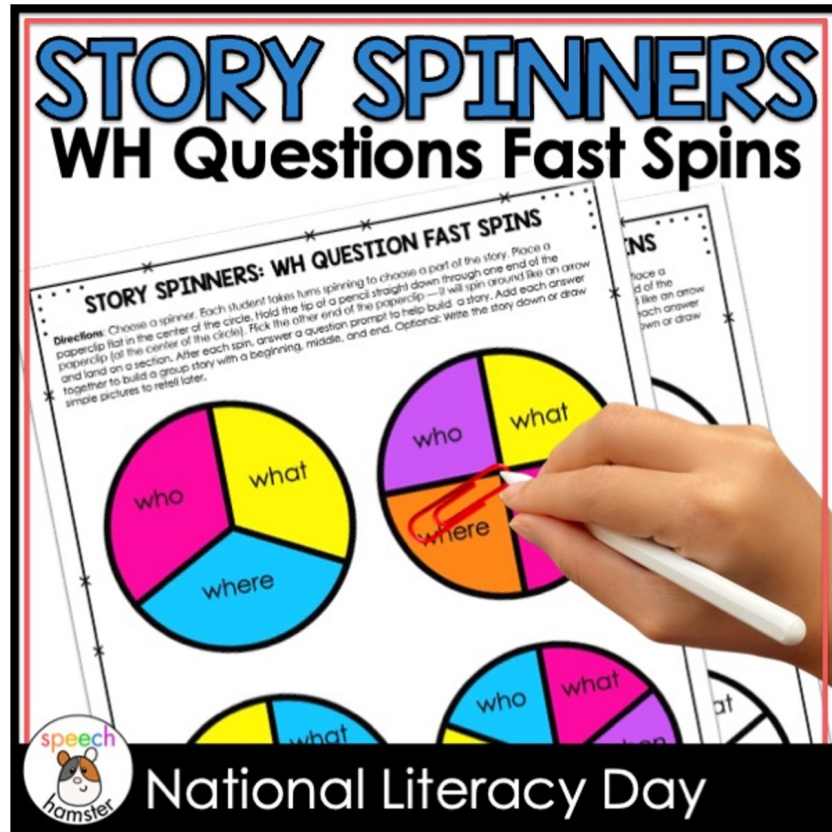

**Directions:**

## 1. Choose Your Spinner

There are 4 options to choose from ranging from 3-6 WH Questions.

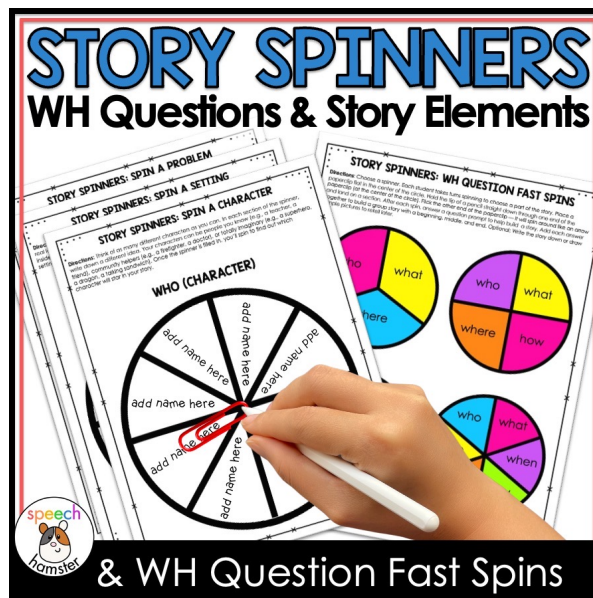
## 2. Make the Spinner Work

- Place a paperclip in the center of the spinner.
- Hold the tip of a pencil straight down through one end of the paperclip in the center circle.
- Flick the other end of the paperclip so it spins like an arrow and lands on a section.

### 3. Play the Game

- Spin to choose a WH question. Add your answer to the response form.
- Keep spinning until you have all the questions answered to create a story.
- Work together to tell the story from beginning to end.
- For extra fun, draw a quick picture of the story or act it out.
